**MR J MARTIN** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR SPORT AND RACING AND MINISTER FOR THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES (HON T MANDER) —

**QUESTION:**

With reference to badminton and table tennis being the fastest growing sports in the Stretton Electorate— Will the Minister advise (a) how the government is planning to support badminton and table tennis in preparation for the 2032 Olympic games and (b) what legacy venues are being considered?

**ANSWER:**

The Queensland Government is committed to getting the Games back on track and creating a lasting legacy that all Queenslanders can be proud of, which will bring transformative infrastructure and drive economic growth across the state and also benefit Australia and the wider Oceania region.

Table Tennis Queensland Incorporated and the Queensland Badminton Association Incorporated are currently funded by the Department of Sport, Racing and Olympic and Paralympic Game, under the Active Industry Base Fund, which supports organisations to build and strengthen their capability to service Queensland's current and emerging needs.

The Games Independent Infrastructure and Coordination Authority was tasked with a 100 Day Review of Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games (Brisbane 2032) infrastructure and planning (the Review).

On 25 March 2025, the Queensland Government released the 2032 Delivery Plan (the Plan) in response to the Review. The Plan identifies the infrastructure required to fulfill the Brisbane 2032 vision while aligning with long-term planning, budget priorities and legacy objectives.
