**HON D FARMER** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND THE ARTS (HON J LANGBROEK)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise what action the Crisafulli LNP Government will take to address the barriers placed on instrumental music teachers in state schools, which relate to their inability to be registered as teachers?

ANSWER:

I am advised:

To maintain full registration with the QCT, teachers must meet the recency of practice requirement. Since 2020, when the QCT last undertook the five-yearly renewal process, it was identified that teaching the Queensland Instrumental Music Curriculum does not currently meet this requirement.

The department, in collaboration with the QCT, the Queensland Teachers' Union and the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority (QCAA), is actively working on proposals to address the issue
