MR C WHITING ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

With reference to the previously allocated \$12.3m for maintenance and equipment upgrades at Redcliffe Hospital—

Will the Minister advise the current status (i.e. in progress, completed etc.) and total expenditure to date on (a) upgrades to the nurse call system, (b) upgrades to the hospital ventilation system and (c) upgrade to the heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems on the Level 6 Ward?

ANSWER

\$12.3 million was inadequate for the currently programmed maintenance and equipment upgrades. The total expenditure in equipment and maintenance upgrades at Redcliffe Hospital for these three projects as of December 2025 is \$19,540,586. This is supported through the Crisafulli Government's new Timely Investment Infrastructure Maintenance program.

In terms of each respective project the current status is:

- a) The Nurse Call Replacement Project was completed May 2025 and as of December 2025 had a total expenditure of \$8,509,073.
- b) The Strategic Ventilation Project had eight phases of work, the final phase was completed in October 2025 and as of December 2025 had a total expenditure of \$9,089,256.
- c) Heating, Ventilation and Air conditioning (HVAC) System Upgrade, Level 6 was completed in May 2024 and as of December 2025 had a total expenditure of \$1,942,257.
