MRS M MCMAHON ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES
(HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the parcel of land acquired in 2024 by the Miles government in York Street, Beenleigh for the purpose of constructing a new police station and ambulance station precinct—

Will the Minister confirm (a) whether his department has committed funds for the construction of the new police station and (b) when construction will commence?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that a replacement police station is being considered as part of the QPS forward plan. Funding allocation will be considered in line with QPS state-wide priorities. If the project is approved to proceed, a program will be developed and include construction commencement timeframes.
