Hon. M Ryan asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the ‘Ministerial Hospitality Costs April to June 2025’ located in <https://www.premiers.qld.gov.au/right-to-info/published-info/assets/Domestic%20hospitality%20and%20catering%20for%20minor%20meetings%20as%20at%2030%20June%202025.pdf>—

Will the Premier advise (a) what the \$4.54 cost to the taxpayer was for his offices’ ‘light refreshments for minor meetings’ and which meeting did this align to in the ministerial diary extracts and (b) provide a breakdown of the items claimed for each office (reported separately by office) in the ‘light refreshments for minor meetings’ category?

ANSWER:

Details of Ministerial hospitality costs are published each quarter on the Department of the Premier and Cabinet’s website at <https://www.premiers.qld.gov.au/right-to-info/published-info/our-finances.aspx> and on the Open Data Portal at <https://www.data.qld.gov.au/dataset/ministerial-hospitality-costs>. These disclosures are in line with the processes used by the former government, and no change to the disclosure process is proposed.

I do not propose to devote departmental resources in providing additional, granular information, that goes far over and above the accepted and longstanding level of disclosure of previous governments.

By way of background, the disclosures indicate the level of expenditure in April to June 2025 are in line with, or below the expenses attributed to ministerial hospitality costs over the past decade.
