MR J KELLY ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

With reference to staffing levels in the Queensland Building and Construction Commission—

Will the Minister advise as at 8 December 2025 (or closest reportable date), in both head count and FTE terms, the number of staff employed (in table format, reported separately by role)?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Building and Construction Commission (QBCC) has been operating with a significant vacancy rate over several years. The new Commissioner and the refreshed Board are taking targeted action to recruit vacant roles and retain talent across the QBCC.

The below table provides the full-time equivalent (FTE) and headcount for the Queensland Building and Construction Commission (QBCC) as at 8 December 2025, per division and branch.

As there are more than 300 different roles across the QBCC, a breakdown by role type is not available.
