MR P RUSSO ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise from 1 May 2025 (or the closest date for which data is recorded) to the latest date for which data is available (a) how many infringements have been issued to personal e-mobility device (PMD) riders and (b) how many non-compliant PMDs have been seized by police?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that:

- a) The number of Traffic Infringement Notices (TINs) issued to personal e-mobility device (PMD) riders from 1 May 2025 to 30 November 2025 is detailed in the following table:

1. This data is preliminary and may be subject to change.
2. Data relates to PMD infringement codes only and has been identified by codes that start with 'P'.
3. TINs have been categorised based on the name of the infringement.
4. This data includes all offence codes with a PMD related infringement.

- b) To provide the number of seizures relating to non-compliant PMDs would require a manual examination of records as non-compliant PMDs are recorded as motorcycles. This is considered by the QPS to be an unjustifiable use of police resources at this time.
