MR L POWER ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the estimated month and year that the new First Nations Housing Action Plan to help meet Closing the Gap targets and improve access to safe, secure housing for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples will be completed and publicly released?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government is developing a new 20-year housing plan which will set out immediate and longer-term actions to support Queenslanders experiencing housing pressures now and plan for a sustainable, stable housing system to 2044.

The 20-year housing plan will include all housing commitments of the Queensland Government, including dedicated actions to meet the housing needs of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Queenslanders.

This will include practical measures to deliver more homes and unlock home ownership opportunities for the first time within remote and discrete Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

The release of the plan will be timed to ensure a comprehensive response to current housing pressures, and is expected to be launched in the first half of 2026.
