**MRS M NIGHTINGALE** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

#### QUESTION:

With reference to Government Employee Housing (GEH)—

Will the Minister advise as at 1 January 2025, or the closest reportable date, (a) how many dwellings are owned and managed by the department for the purpose of housing government employees, (b) where they are located (by electorate) and (c) how many dwellings are not currently tenanted?

#### ANSWER:

As at 1 January 2025, the Department of Housing and Public Works owns and manages 3059 general purpose government employee housing residences located across the following electorates:
