**HON M FURNER** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR SPORT AND RACING AND MINISTER FOR THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES (HON T MANDER) —

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the LNP's election commitment to deliver a Business Case to upgrade the Mitchelton Youth Club—

Will the Minister advise if the government remains committed to the project, and if so (a) the total cost to deliver the Business Case, (b) what work has been undertaken by the Department of Sport, Racing and Olympic and Paralympic Games thus far to progress the Business Case, (c) projected date the Business Case will be completed and provided to government and (d) projected date the Business Case will be publicly released for community consultation?

**ANSWER:**

The Government will honour all election commitments.

Delivery of election commitments are integrated into departmental budgets and require Cabinet and Parliamentary approvals to reflect progress and expenditure. This process ensures transparency and accountability, while the Government works towards fulfilling promises to the electorate within a responsible fiscal framework.
