HON G GRACE ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

With reference to government owned land in Ivory Street, Fortitude Valley and the related Business Case for a large-scale housing development announced by the former Miles Labor Government—

Will the Minister advise (a) whether the Minister has received a draft or final version of the Business Case, (b) the current status of the Business Case as at 1 April 2025, (c) if the Minister and/or Cabinet have considered the Business Case in any form (draft or otherwise), (d) when the final Business Case will be completed and (e) when the final Business Case will be publicly released?

ANSWER:

The Department of Housing and Public Works has substantially progressed the development of the business case, however as at 1 April 2025 the Minister and Cabinet has not received or considered a draft of the business case.

It is expected the business case will be finalised for Government consideration later this year.

As the business case is yet to be considered, the status of its publication is yet to be determined.
