Mr S Miles asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise (a) the total number of external reviews currently being conducted by the government (in table format, reported separately by review name and responsible minister/department) and (b) the total cost of each review (including staffing remuneration, administration and cost reimbursements) (in table format, reported separately by review name and cost)?

ANSWER:

It is unclear from the Member's phrasing of the question what information the Member is requesting when referring to "external reviews".

For example, the Member may be referring to "external reviews" conducted by persons engaged from outside of the Queensland Government that examine government policies, operations, or projects. The Member may also be referring to "external reviews" undertaken by The Office of the Information Commissioner to review decisions made by agencies and Ministers under the Right to Information Act 2009 (RTI Act) and Information Privacy Act 2009 (IP Act).

As such, I am unable to answer the Member's question.
