QUESTION:

With reference to appointments made under specific legislation and Governor-in-Council, for example the Electoral Commissioner, Integrity Commissioner etc—

Will the Attorney-General advise if the Attorney-General commits to undertaking a full merit-based recruitment process for all Governor-in-Council positions in their portfolio, as they become vacant?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Gaven for her question.

I can confirm that all Governor-in-Council appointments made by the Crisafulli Government have been and will continue to be merit-based.
