MS B ASIF ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the QPS Child Protection Offender Registry (CPOR)—

Will the Minister advise, as at 31 March 2025, the approved strength and the actual headcount for Child Protection Offender Registry coordinators (in table format, reported separately by police district)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the position of Child Protection Offender Registry Coordinator does not exist.

I am further advised as at 31 March 2025 the Child Protection Offender Registry is comprised of Senior Investigator / Investigator (Detective) positions. The approved permanent positions and substantive headcount is presented by District in the table below.
