MR B MELLISH ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the police officer attrition rate for the Queensland Police Service (QPS)—

Will the Minister provide (reported separately by time period), the attrition rate for (a) 1 April 2024 to 30 June 2024 (Quarter 4 of FY23-24), (b) 1 July 2024 to 30 September 2024 (Quarter 1 of FY2425), (c) 1 October 2024 to 31 December 2024 (Quarter 2 of FY24-25) and (d) 1 January 2025 to 31 March 2025 (Quarter 3 of FY24-25)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) of the following information regarding the police officer attrition rate (pro rata for each period):

For the period 1 April 2024 to 30 June 2024 the attrition rate was 5.3%:

- 2.8% planned attrition (Age Retirement and Medical Retirement)
- 2.5% unplanned attrition (Resignation, Voluntary Retirement and Other)

For the period July 2024 to 30 September 2024 the attrition rate was 6.5%:

- 3.2% planned attrition (Age Retirement and Medical Retirement)
- 3.3% unplanned attrition (Resignation, Voluntary Retirement and Other)

For the period 1 October 2024 to 31 December 2024 the attrition rate was 5.6%:

- 2.4% planned attrition (Age Retirement and Medical Retirement)
- 3.2% unplanned attrition (Resignation, Voluntary Retirement and Other)

For the period 1 January 2025 to 31 March 2025 the attrition rate was 5.6%:

- 2.7% planned attrition (Age Retirement and Medical Retirement)
- 2.9% unplanned attrition (Resignation, Voluntary Retirement and Other)
