HON S FENTIMAN ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND THE ARTS (HON J LANGBROEK)

QUESTION:

With reference to the former Labor Government's Share the Dignity in Queensland schools initiative—

Will the Minister advise (a) the number of schools or eligible education facilities that have registered to participate in the initiative and (b) if any of these schools or eligible education facilities have been rejected?

ANSWER:

I am advised:

- a) As of 4 April 2025, 775 schools and eligible education facilities have registered to participate in the initiative. This figure does not include 16 non-state schools which were selected to participate in the initiative but were not required to register.
- b) No schools or eligible education facilities have had their registration rejected.
