**HON C DICK** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister provide, as at 31 March 2025, the total number of FTE staff employed within the Queensland Police Service in the Domestic, Family Violence and DNA Reform Program (in table format) reported separately by (a) Business Management, (b) Program Management and (c) SubProgram Coordination, and System Engagement?

**ANSWER:**

I am advised that as at 31 March 2025, there are no staff members appointed to Business Management, Sub-Program Coordination, or System Engagement.

I am further advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that as at 31 March 2025, there are 7 substantive staff members in the Domestic, Family Violence and DNA Reform Program. They are appointed to the following units:

Furthermore, I am informed that there are an additional 9 Police Officers and 4 Staff Members on higher duties within the Domestic, Family Violence and DNA Reform Program.

I have also been advised that the Domestic Family Violence and DNA Reform Program is in the process of being disestablished. The Domestic Family Violence and Vulnerable Persons Command will assume responsibility for the functions previously held by the Domestic Family Violence and DNA Reform Program. The organisation units Business Management, Program Management, Sub-Program Coordination, and System Engagement will be closed as part of the disestablishment.
