HON L LINARD ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS

QUESTION:

With reference to the Banyo Train Station Accessibility Upgrade—

Will the Minister advise (a) the date commuter rail services will recommence from Banyo Station and (b) when heavy vehicle movement and traffic management onsite will cease, so that road users and pedestrians again have clear egress over the crossing?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

I am pleased to announce that Banyo station re-opened to customers on Monday 26 May 2025.

Pedestrians are once again able to use the level crossing freely, as traffic management measures are no longer in place, however the community may see some minimal truck movements in and out of the site office while final construction materials and equipment are removed.
