MS J HOWARD ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

With reference to the former Labor Government's commitment to expand the then Ripley Satellite Hospital (now Health Centre)—

Will the Minister advise (a) if the Crisafulli LNP Government will maintain the commitment to complete the new sub-acute care facility and multistorey carpark, (b) forecast practical completion date and (c) forecast date for services to open?

ANSWER

As outlined in the Hospital Rescue Plan, the Crisafulli Government is committed to delivering the Ripley Satellite Health Centre 90-bed Sub-acute Expansion and car park. Due to fiscal mismanagement of the Sustaining Capital Program prior to October 2024, additional funding is required to complete both projects. Services are expected to commence late 2025 following practical completion. Work is underway to develop a suitable approach to delivering the car park.
