MS W BOURNE ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (in table format, reported separately by watch-house and age group for every day within each month) the occupancy numbers of each watch-house in Queensland for (a) February 2025, (b) March 2025 and (c) April 2025?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) the daily occupancy rates for each watchhouse across Queensland is outlined in the tables below:

Notes:

1. This data is preliminary and may be subject to change.
2. Data includes both youth and adults in custody for any reason.
3. A person who was in custody for three days is counted in *against* each of the three days.
4. Persons in custody is calculated based on the number of persons in custody every 4 hours from midnight. The maximum number of persons in that day is used.
5. Youths are persons aged between 10 and 17 years.
6. Adults are persons aged 18 years and over.
7. Only persons who are in custody one or more hours are included.
