Hon. S Miles asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise if the Premier, the Office of the Premier or the Office of the Director-General are aware of any acts of noncompliance with the Queensland Ministerial Handbook since 1 November 2024, and if so (a) the nature of the non-compliance, (b) the names or positions involved and (c) the actions taken by the Premier or department due to the noncompliance?

ANSWER:

The Ministerial Handbook provides guidance to all Ministers, Assistant Ministers and staff on the operations of their offices and I am advised that routine meetings occur between the Office of the Premier and the Department of the Premier and Cabinet regarding ministerial services matters, including points of clarification on the Ministerial Handbook.

I am further advised that while questions of alleged non-compliance have been raised with the department, they have been reviewed and assessed by the Director-General.
