## Question on Notice No. 450 Asked on 1 May 2025

MR J SULLIVAN ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

## QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise between 1 November 2024 and 1 January 2025 (or closest reportable dates), (in table format, reported separately by rate, number, offence and Police District) the (a) rate and (b) total number of Other Theft Offences (excluding unlawful entry)?

## ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the category of other theft offences (excluding unlawful entry) includes stealing from dwellings, shop stealing, vehicles (steal from/enter with intent) and other stealing. I am also advised by the QPS that the number and rate of other theft offences (excluding unlawful entry) between 1 November 2024 and 1 January 2025 is detailed in the table below:
