MR P RUSSO ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise between 1 January 2025 and 1 March 2025 (or closest reportable dates), (in a table format, reported separately by rate, number, offence and Police District), the (a) rate and (b) total number of Other Theft Offences (excluding unlawful entry)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the category of other theft offences (excluding unlawful entry) include stealing from dwellings, shop stealing, vehicles (steal from/enter with intent) and other stealing. I am also advised by the QPS that the number and rate of other theft offences (excluding unlawful entry) between 1 January 2025 and 1 March 2025 is detailed in the table below:
