MS WENDY BOURNE ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES
(HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister (a) support the Queensland Police Union in supplying personalised tourniquets to all Queensland Officers and (b) if so, when?

ANSWER:

On 25 February 2025 I announced a \$5.399 million investment over **the** next five years **to** purchase around 12,500 **Tactical First Aid Kits** to increase the personal safety of police officers.

The trauma response kits are designed to be used in high-risk incidents where life-threatening injuries, including penetrating trauma and severe haemorrhaging, may occur.

Tactical First Aid Kits have been supplied within all police vehicles since 2017. As at 21 February 2025, 7,945 Tactical First Aid Kits have been delivered to frontline officers.

This additional measure will further support our police officers and represents an investment in their safety, their ability to save lives and their capacity to protect the public in critical situations.
