MRS C MULLEN ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Disaster Management Training Framework—

Will the Minister advise the Chairperson and Members of the Queensland Disaster Management Committee (QDMC) who have (a) completed the mandatory induction (reported separately by chairperson, member and the date the induction was completed) and (b) not yet completed the mandatory induction and when this induction is scheduled (reported separately by chairperson, member and the date training and/or induction is scheduled)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the membership of the Queensland Disaster Management Committee (QDMC) is legislated under the Queensland Disaster Management Act 2003.

Queensland Disaster Management Arrangements training is available via an online platform or alternatively by face-to-face delivery. Once training has been completed the Secretariat completes the induction with the member.

As such, I am advised by the QPS that the details of members of the QDMC who are required to complete mandatory training/induction, and the dates on which training/induction was completed, are outlined in the table below:
