MS B ASIF ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Northern Busway Project—

Will the Minister advise what work has been undertaken by the Department of Transport and Main Roads on increasing bus routes and service frequency for residents of Bracken Ridge?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The Crisafulli Government is committed to delivering public transport that is affordable, reliable, frequent and safe.

There are several major transport projects and land use changes occurring in the northern Brisbane area which impact the bus network in Bracken Ridge that will be considered as part of network planning. These include the introduction of the Northern Transitway, Cross River Rail, and the ongoing development of Northshore Hamilton and Skygate, and the closure of Toombul Shopping Centre.

I can confirm that the Department of Transport and Main Roads will continue to work with Brisbane City Council to identify improvements to the bus network in Bracken Ridge and the broader northern Brisbane area, which will be considered against a number of priorities across the state.
