HON M BAILEY ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the proposed date, including the month and year, when the full accessibility upgrades will be completed at the Moorooka and Salisbury train stations as part of the Cross River Rail project?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The past administration of the Cross River Rail project resulted in significant cost and time blowouts. The Crisafulli Government is determined to get the project back on track.

Salisbury station major works are expected to be finished by mid-2026, with the exact timing subject to weather conditions. The station will reopen to customers once all works and testing and commissioning activities are completed.

Moorooka station remains open to customers with only early works underway. Once the station design has been finalised, major construction on Moorooka station is expected to commence in 2026. The schedule for Moorooka station's reopening will be confirmed in consultation with Queensland Rail and Translink.
