QUESTION:

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 298 of 2025— Will the Attorney-General advise for each meeting of the Judicial Appointments Advisory Panel since the election of the Crisafulli LNP Government (a) the names of the attendees and (b) which part of the protocol they relate to?

ANSWER:

Naming members of the Judicial Appointments Advisory Panel would undermine the integrity of the judicial appointments process.

The Member would be aware, as a former minister, that members of selection panels across government are not typically made public so as to not compromise the assessment of candidates.

The Judicial Appointments Protocol ensures that participants in the judicial appointments process maintain the confidentiality of candidates and panel deliberations.
