MR N DAMETTO ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the financial burden placed on victims of crime, including the cost of replacing stolen or damaged driver licences—

Will the Minister consider waiving the cost of replacement driver licences for victims of crime?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The Crisafulli Government is committed to supporting victims of crime and alleviating financial stress to enable victims to focus on recovery. Waiving the replacement costs of driver licences, and additionally, number plates, for victims of crime was an election commitment and the Crisafulli Government will honour all of its election commitments.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is implementing the legislative amendments and system upgrades to facilitate the implementation of this commitment.
