MS J PEASE asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the \$350m Incentivising Infill Development Fund (IIDF) established under the Homes for Queenslanders plan to support infrastructure upgrades that increase housing—

Will the Deputy Premier advise which projects received funding under the IIDF, including (a) the location of each project, (b) the amount of funding approved, (c) the trunk infrastructure funded and (d) the estimated number of homes and/or lots enabled by each project?

Unlike the Crisafulli Government's landmark \$2 billion Residential Activation Fund, the IIDF does not fund trunk infrastructure.
