MR T SMITH ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the June 2024 update of the Independent Review of Queensland Homelessness responses, which identified 13 immediate actions to be implemented within three months—

Will the Minister advise which of the 13 immediate actions identified for three-month implementation have been (a) completed, (b) partially completed or still in progress, (c) not commenced and (d) no longer being progressed?

ANSWER:

The Independent review of the homelessness response in Queensland provided initial findings (including 13 recommendations) in June 2024.

The Liberal National Party formed government following the 26 October 2024 state election. As such, the three-month implementation period fell entirely during the Labor Party's term of government.

In relation to the three-month implementation period, I am advised the Member that the former Labor government had not completed the actioning of any of the recommendations within this period.

This Crisafulli Government is working hard to deliver the change Queenslanders voted for, including a positive new direction for Queensland's housing system.
