## **QUESTION:**

Will the Minister provide the number of Police Protection Notices (PPNs) issued (in table format, reported separately by month and police district) from April 2024 to March 2025 (inclusive)?

## **ANSWER:**

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service that there were a total of 19,594 Police Protection Notices (PPNs) issued from April 2024 to March 2025.
