QUESTION

Will the Minister advise how much has been spent, in time and planning funds, for the planned expansion to the Prince Charles Hospital Emergency Department and Children's Emergency Department both from TPCH and Metro North Infrastructure teams?

ANSWER

The Crisafulli Government is ensuring every Queenslander can access health services when they need them. The Hospital Rescue Plan is an investment in the future of our health system, delivering more than 2,600 new beds right across metro, regional and rural Queensland – alongside more investment in a bigger health workforce.

The Prince Charles Hospital (TPCH) Expansion Project is a key deliverable of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

The Emergency Department and Children's Emergency Department components form part of this project. I am advised that through the planning phase, \$5.7 million was expended to develop the project to the point of an endorsed Project Validation Report.
