MR J KELLY ASKED THE MINISTER FOR SPORT AND RACING AND MINISTER FOR THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES (HON T MANDER) —

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise what State Sporting Organisations (SSOs) are required to provide for community sporting clubs under the service agreements between the State Government and the SSOs in (a) Rugby League, (b) Netball, (c) Rugby Union, (d) Lawn Bowls, (e) Touch Football, (f) Swimming, (g) Soccer and (h) Cricket?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government supports State Sporting Organisations, via the Active Industry Base Fund 2023-2025 (AIBF), as administered by the Department of Sport, Racing and Olympic and Paralympic Games. AIBF provides funding to eligible organisations (including the industry peak bodies for the above listed sports) to build and strengthen the capability of their activity or sector to service Queensland's current and emerging needs resulting in improved participation opportunities. Key areas of delivery, include:

- Skills and ability delivery of education and training including for coaching, officials and volunteers.
- Provision of resources to support volunteers and members, for example child safeguarding resources.
- Development and delivery of systems and processes that support member organisations to provide quality participation experiences.
