In 2025, Queensland state schools received the Behaviour Boost resource through the Whole School Support – Student Learning Resource allocation (WSS-SLR). WSS-SLR is a resource provided to schools for additional staffing above the core allocation for teachers and teacher aides.

Each school's WSS-SLR allocation is calculated based on a range of factors, including enrolment numbers and socio-economic advantage.
