HON M FURNER asked the Minister for Families, Seniors and Disability Services and Minister for Child Safety and the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence (HON A CAMM)—

QUESTION

With reference to the election campaign and the LNP commitment to investing \$383 million in the *Safer Children, Safer Communities* plan—

Will the Minister provide (a) the details on the expected timeframe for the full delivery of this plan, (b) when detailed information will be released and (c) a breakdown of how the \$383 million in funding will be allocated across programs, services, and regions?

ANSWER

I have announced detailed information under the 2025–26 Budget for \$164.1 million over four years from 2025–26 to support the *Safer Children, Safer Communities* plan focused on reforming the residential care system and protecting Queensland's most vulnerable children and young people.

In response to part b and c of the question, further details of the \$383 million *Safer Children, Safer Communities* plan is subject to future Government consideration.
