QUESTION

With reference to the election campaign and the LNP commitment to investing \$383 million in the Safer Children, Safer Communities plan—

Will the Minister provide (a) the details on the expected timeframe for the full delivery of this plan, (b) when detailed information will be released and (c) a breakdown of how the \$383 million in funding will be allocated across programs, services, and regions?

ANSWER

I have announced detailed information under the 2025–26 Budget for \$164.1 million over four years from 2025–26 to support the *Safer Children, Safer Communities* plan focused on reforming the residential care system and protecting Queensland's most vulnerable children and young people.

Details can be found on page 2 of my Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety's 2025-26 Service Delivery Statements¹.

In response to part b and c of the question, further details of the \$383 million Safer Children, Safer Communities plan is subject to future Government consideration.
