QUESTION:

With reference to covert speed cameras in Queensland School Zone signs—

Will the Treasurer advise (reported separately by number, region and month), the total infringement notices issued for the periods (a) 1 July 2024 to 31 December 2024 (or closest reportable dates) and (b) 1 January 2025 to 1 April 2025 (or closest reportable dates)?

ANSWER:

I am advised that, with reference to school zone speed cameras which are part of the Roadways Behaviour Monitoring System trial —

The total number of infringement notices issued for the period 1 July 2024 to 31 December 2024 is 6,087. The total number of infringement notices issued for the period 1 January 2025 to 31 March 2025 is 2,180.
