MR T SMITH ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the (a) rate and (b) total number of victims, of homicide (murder) and all other homicide offences between 1 November 2024 and 1 January 2025 (in table format, reported separately by rate, number, offence and Police District)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service that the number and rate of reported victims of homicide (murder) and other homicide offences from 1 November 2024 to 1 January 2025 is detailed in the table below:
