QUESTION:

With reference to relocatable buildings utilised for educational purposes (e.g. classrooms)—

Will the Minister advise (in table format, reported separately by region), (a) the total number currently used in Queensland state schools and (b) the total cost of construction and installation?

ANSWER:

I am advised:

(a) As at 30 June 2025, there were approximately 2,861 prefabricated buildings located across Queensland state schools, separated by region:

Metropolitan North	372
Metropolitan South	482

(b) The total cost of construction and installation* of prefabricated buildings in Queensland state schools in the 2024–25 financial year was \$99.7 million across 57 buildings.

It is not possible to attribute construction costs to a specific region.
