MS W BOURNE ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)

QUESTION:

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 124 of 2025 in relation to the safety of the intersection of Haigslea-Amberley Road, Schultz Road and the Warrego Highway where the Minister committed to the completion of a speed limit review—

Will the Minister advise, given the number of deaths, accidents and feedback that people are now too scared to use this intersection (a) the outcome of the speed limit review and (b) when is this vital safety upgrade being considered?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government is committed to completing the speed limit review (SLR) for the Warrego Highway, including the intersection of Haigslea-Amberley Road, so that local residents' safety can be maintained.

Previous advice in response to petitions 4116-24 and 4157-24—tabled by the former Minister for Transport and Main Roads and Minister for Digital Services on 20 September 2024—indicated that the SLR would be completed in 2024, however, this did not occur.

The SLR is currently underway and therefore the outcomes are unable to be shared. The results of the SLR will be considered in the usual process following completion to determine the appropriate next steps.

The SLR takes into consideration crash history over the past five years. Any evidence that the Member has in relation to the feedback which the Member asserts should be provided to my department for inclusion in the SLR.
