QUESTION:

With reference to previous work and funding by the former Labor Government on the Gold Coast East-West Passenger Transport Study—

Will the Minister advise when my community can expect high frequency transport from Nerang to Carrara to be operational?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The Crisafulli Government's *2032 Delivery Plan* identifies the major infrastructure required to support the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games. This includes implementing bus priority measures to improve east-west connectivity on the Gold Coast (including between Nerang and Carrara).

The Central Gold Coast East-West Passenger Transport Study was completed in 2023 and identified Nerang to Broadbeach and Miami to Robina as key east-west public transport corridors for further investigation.

As part of the *Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program 2025–26 to 2028–29*, the Crisafulli Government has committed additional funding for the Nerang to Broadbeach public transport route, business case (Investment ID 3113540) to ensure the critical next phase of planning can commence in early 2026 and improved bus priority is delivered in the corridor ahead of the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.
