Mr S Knuth asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Premier recently confirming that no vaccine mandates were currently in place in any State Government departments—

Will the Premier (a) confirm if any ongoing disciplinary actions are currently in place against any state government department employee who refused to abide by imposed vaccine mandates and (b) commit to reinstating those staff who were or are suspended, stood down or fired for refusing to abide by the vaccine mandate?

ANSWER:

There are no vaccine mandates currently in place, as I advised in the House during Question Time on 12 June 2025.

I am advised by the Public Sector Commission (PSC) as follows.

There are a small number of open matters. Due to the fact there are so few ongoing matters, I am unable to provide further details for privacy reasons.

In accordance with standard recruitment and selection practices, it is open to former employees who were terminated for this purpose to apply for roles within the Queensland Government.
