MR B MELLISH ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)

QUESTION:

With reference to QTRIP—

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by Investment ID and Project title), the projects that have been reprofiled (meaning, but not limited to, funding moved from the existing year in the last budget to a new year in the current budget)?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

As part of any responsible government's approach to infrastructure investment, there is a need to manage government expenditure in a way that achieves the best outcome for the community, while respecting Queensland taxpayers' money.

The Crisafulli Government announced the *Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program 2025–26 to 2028–29*, with \$41.7 billion committed to building a better-connected, safer, and a more resilient transport network, which includes the following key projects:

- Bruce Highway Targeted Safety Program
- Logan and Gold Coast Faster Rail
- The Wave Stage 1
- Coomera Connector Stage 1, Barron River Bridge, Rockhampton Ring Road, Tiaro Bypass and Gateway and M1 upgrades
- Caloundra Congestion Busting Plan and Mooloolah River Interchange.

These investments set the priorities for the Crisafulli Government and will create opportunities for Queenslanders, strengthen local economies, and prepare the network for the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

As outlined in section 1.5 of *The Queensland Cabinet Handbook*—any document which would reveal any consideration or deliberation of Cabinet, or otherwise prejudice the confidentiality of Cabinet considerations, deliberations or operations is a Cabinet document.
