MS N BOYD ASKED THE MINISTER FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND WATER AND MINISTER FOR FIRE, DISASTER RECOVERY AND VOLUNTEERS (HON A LEAHY)—

QUESTION:

With reference to new land that has been purchased to construct a new fire station in Bundaberg—

Will the Minister advise total funding budgeted in 2025-26 and across the forward estimates to (a) be in construction on and (b) deliver this new station?

ANSWER:

I am advised that the Queensland Fire Department (QFD) strategically purchased land in Bundaberg East on 13 May 2024 to secure a site for a future fire and rescue station.

The QFD continues to monitor service delivery in Bundaberg and undertakes an annual state-wide review to inform BP3 priorities. This review informs when the station will be included in a future BP3.

The Crisafulli Government is engaging directly with frontline crews and QFD to deliver the right station with the right resources.
