MS C MCMILLAN ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister (a) advise why the Crisafulli LNP Government has reduced funding for government employee housing and (b) outline the impact the reduced funding will have on providing for government employees, particularly in regional Queensland?

ANSWER:

The premise of the Member's question is incorrect.

The Crisafulli Government has not reduced funding for the Government Employee Housing (GEH) portfolio.

In fact, we are continuing to invest in strengthening housing options for essential frontline in regional and remote communities, including police, teachers and health workers.

The Department of Housing and Public Works is on track to provide up to 439 additional residences, as well as upgrades and asset renewals to the current portfolio over the next two years.
