MR P RUSSO ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide a breakdown of the \$147.9m over five years allocated for various equipment for police (in table format, reported separately by equipment type and by year)?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government's Budget is delivering \$147.9 million to bolster the Queensland Police Service (QPS) with upgrades and improvements to critical operational equipment to make Queensland safer. This figure is to provide funding for each operational equipment item over 5 years.

I am advised by the QPS that the breakdown of the funding allocation is as follows:
