HON M RYAN ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the total committed funding for head-leasing (reported separately by financial year and corresponding program)?

ANSWER:

The previous government budgeted \$200.2M over five years for Headleasing from 2024-25 to 2028-29. In comparison, the Crisafulli Government has committed \$328.7M over five years, representing a \$128.5M funding increase in the 2025-26 Budget.

This funding increase will support the continued delivery of essential housing for Queenslanders with nowhere else to go, allowing us to secure more properties across the state and better meet the diverse needs of those we serve while long-term housing supply comes online.

A breakdown reported separately by financial year is provided below.
