QUESTION:

With reference to page 8 of Budget Paper 4—

Will the Minister advise the formula for deciding how the \$222.1m More Teachers, Better Education will be allocated between schools?

ANSWER:

I am advised:

The \$222.1 million has been allocated to the Department of Education to deliver a number of commitments under the *More teachers, Better education* plan providing more support to schools, teachers and to students. This includes more support to address and respond to student behaviour in Queensland state schools, more support to prevent and respond to bullying, and a boost to professional development.

For response to student behaviour, please refer to Question on Notice 630-2025.

For response to bullying, funding is based on the needs of individual schools.

For professional development, funding opportunities may be funded directly through contracts with training providers and institutions, via payment of bursaries or grants to individuals and/or coverage of costs for in-house development and delivery of training.
