MR L POWER ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise (a) how much of the \$20m allocated in the 2024-25 Budget to advance the implementation of the Queensland Cancer Strategy 2024 has been spent so far and (b) if proton beam therapy service remains in the scope of the Queensland Cancer Centre project?

ANSWER

The Crisafulli Government is committed to delivering a world-class health system for Queenslanders. This includes supporting delivery of high-quality cancer care services across Queensland.

- a) The 2024-25 State Budget allocated \$5- million for expenditure in the 2024-25 financial year. Information about how much of the \$5 million was spent by the areas it was allocated to will be available after the end of the 2024-25 financial year, following the standard end-of-year reconciliation process that occurs between the Department and hospital and health services.
